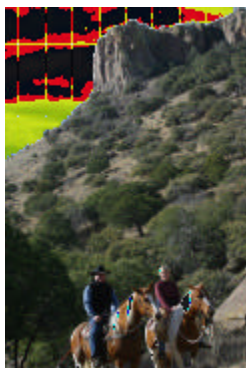
Greetings from Livermore Ranch!
